- Options: 20 periods – 4 subjects for 5 periods each so 325mins each

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(Week 1 Opt 1 and 2 for 3 periods, Opt 3 and 4 for 2 periods; then reverse for Week 2)

Option 1: a guided choice from Computer Science, French, Geography, History or Triple Science

Options 2/3/4: free choices from: Art, Business Studies, Child Development, Computer Science, Drama, Film Studies, French, Food Technology, Geography, History, ICT, Music, Product Design, PE, RE, Resistant Materials and Textiles

Vocational courses are offered at KS4 by working as part of a consortium with 3 other local secondary schools and these are delivered by 3 local colleges.

In Year 11 2014-15 students were studying Animal Care (5), Construction (4), Hair& Beauty (5) and Motor Vehicle (3)

In Year 11 2015-16 students will continue studying Construction (8) and Performing Arts (4)

In Year 10 2015-16 students are due to study Animal Care (8), Hair& Beauty (4) and Performing Arts (2)
