## End of Year Arrangements

The end of the academic year is nearly upon us and students will be embarking on their Active Learning Week programme next week. That makes this week our final full week of normal school programme this year. However, there is very little that is normal about this week's activities!

Firstly, tomorrow will be the 'WAT Games' where a number of our students will be competing against other schools within the Trust at both primary and secondary level to see who our greatest athletes are across the Trust.

On Thursday we will be undertaking a school photography day to obtain promotional photographs for forthcoming prospectuses, website and the like. I would ask that you support the school by ensuring that students are wearing their full uniform on that day.

Friday will be the last day before Active Learning Week and we will be holding year group awards and rewards assemblies throughout the afternoon. This will be a non uniform day: students may dress predominately in their House colours for a donation of £1.00, or in any other non uniform attire for a donation of £2.00. School will run at the usual times throughout this week.

Next week is Active Learning Week. Many students will be on residential trips and you should now have all of the information regarding these trips. Students who are not on any of these residential trips will be expected to attend Monday – Wednesday as normal and at the usual times, unless otherwise agreed for a specific activity or trip.

On Thursday, the timings of the school day will be adjusted to accommodate those students who are returning from trips. For most students, school will start at 10.00 am, followed by the whole school celebration ending by 1.00 pm. Any students wishing to receive their free school meals on that day will be able to order it from the Refectory at break time.



Students returning from the Krakow and Madrid trips, as they will be travelling back late / early Thursday morning, will be asked to join us for the celebrations from 11.20 am so they have a chance to recover from their long journeys.

The entire week will be a non-uniform week with no required donations. On the final day we encourage all students to wear their House colours as far as possible for this celebratory event.

May I take this opportunity to thank you all for your support this year. We look forward to welcoming our students back revitalised in September, a further letter and newsletter will follow to confirm start of term arrangements.
